Does the term “AUDITION” give you cold feet? Let me reassure you that we have an audition system that is very easy and family friendly. Here’s how it works:

1. Complete the Choir/Orchestra Application
2. Schedule an appointment with Susan McQuinn nl.nlmusic@yahoo.com to come to a Wednesday night rehearsal at 7:15 pm in the Chappell
3. Participate in the rehearsal where you will
 - *have a five to ten minute interview with a current choir member
 - * have a *group* vocal audition

When you arrive we will connect you with a choir member who will walk you through the evening. (We remember what it was like to be the new kid!)

The group audition gives us the opportunity to hear you in a smaller group of people without making you sing by yourself.

It is NOT necessary to read music. The choir learns mainly by listening to Part CDs.

Orchestra Audition Info

Auditions for the Orchestra are very simple:

1. Complete the Choir/Orchestra Application
2. Schedule an audition appointment with Susan McQuinn nl.nlmusic@yahoo.com
3. At the audition, play a piece of your choosing.
4. Sight-read some music as we will give you to determine your level of performance.
5. Sit in on a rehearsal on Wednesday evening at 8:30 in the Sanctuary
